Administrative report (Carma)

- Focus on a welcoming, caring, and safe school
- Mental wellbeing and academic success
- Commitment to seeking a sense of belonging for every student
- There are now two resource teachers
- Strong academic programming, clubs, fine arts, sports, trades, and language programming
- EPS students have a higher sense of belonging than the average Canadian student, the difference is especially significant in EPS girls as compared to the average Canadian girl
- Anxiety and depression levels in EPS students are less than the Canadian averages
- EPS student have a slightly higher sense of feeling safe at school as compared to the Canadian average
- Terry Fox run will have food trucks this year
- Upcoming trips include the Japanese exchange, a possible band trip to Toronto, and the Europe trip will be next year

- Planning for outcome based assessment (OBA) and proficiency scales for grade tens
- Current enrollment is 1827, which is slightly higher than last year Class size has also increased
- Over the summer, we had three new classrooms built
- We are hoping to confirm this winter that we will be receiving six new modulars next summer
